Build a fort and read your book with a flashlight for 15 minutes.	Write and draw a picture about your favorite character from a book, movie, or TV show.	Create and solve 3-5 word problems using the CUBES method.	Watch a social studies BrainPop Jr. video and take the quiz.
Use the sight word list to make flashcards and practice.	Pretend you are interviewing the main character of a story. Write 3 - 5 questions you would ask the character.	Create ten addition and/or subtraction problems with two or three digits.	Write about why we need rules and laws.
Read the article from ReadWorks and answer the questions.	Write a summary of something you have read today. Include the beginning, middle, and end.	Draw and label an analog clock showing what time you woke up, ate lunch, and completed your homework.	Use household items to create a course that a ball or toy car will roll through. Draw a sketch of the course you created.
