Device Distribution

- Students will check out their iPads/Chromebooks and power cord from Destiny, our media center checkout system.
- Student devices will be tagged with student-assigned numbers and homeroom number.
- Student device, power cord, folder with login information, and parent/student usage agreement will be sent home in a bag each day. If school is in session, the bag should be returned to school each day. If we are having a Digital Learning Day, the bag will then be available for use at home during the school closure.
- **Students and parents will sign and follow usage guidelines.**
- **Students will use their device to learn from home. Parents and students will take responsibility for the tech device and power cord.**
- **Devices should be used for educational purposes only.**
- **Devices must be charged every night.**

Delivery of Instruction & Monitoring of Student Learning

Catoosa County Public Schools provides a Digital Learning Plan designed to provide students with access to learning during inclement weather days or other school closures. The goal is to provide continuous learning for all students.

Where do I find the assignments for Digital Learning Days?

All students K - 5 will have access to assignments through Google Classroom. All students will also have a Choice Board of learning activities for Reading, Math, Writing, and Science/Social Studies which will either be sent home as a hard copy or can be accessed on the GES website. Specific instructions will be provided.

How long should my child spend on each assignment?

Each assignment on the Choice Board should take about 10 - 20 minutes to complete. Assignments in Google Classroom for 3rd - 5th grades may take longer, depending on the nature of the material. Students should spend no more than 1.5 to 2 hours a day on assignments.

How do I communicate with my child's teacher?

Parents can communicate with teachers by sending and receiving messages through email, Bloomz or Dojo. Teacher emails may be accessed on the school website under Staff Directory. Please email the teacher if you are not already set up for these communication apps. Teachers will be monitoring student progress and will be available to answer questions and address concerns. Through Google Classroom, teachers will be able to view student work, give feedback to students, and give instructions for assignments. Google assignments will be posted daily.


What do I do if my child's device does not work?

Make sure the device is charged and connected to WIFI. Contact your child's teacher through email, Bloomz, or Dojo. You may also contact our media center specialist, Kay Hardeman, at khardeman.ges@catoosa.k12.ga.us

What if we don't have WIFI?

You could go to a friend or family member's house where WIFI is available, go to the public library in our community, or go to a business that offers public WIFI. Contact your child's teacher if you are unable to access WIFI in any of these ways.
