#### Things To Do Now....

- 1. Sign up for Infinite Campus Parent Portal. If you are already signed up, your username and password will not change when your student comes to RMS.
- Visit the RMS website with your child and see what sports, clubs, and organizations are offered. Find one area where you can get involved.
- If your child wants to play fall sports (football, volleyball, softball, or cross-country), he/she will need a sports physical. You must use the Georgia High School Association form located on our website.
- Wait for a text. SchoolCast Text alerts will automatically enroll you over the summer to receive texts from RMS.

#### Things To Do Then...

- 1. **Get involved!** We welcome all parents/guardians to RMS. Sign up to volunteer, mentor, or be a booster parent to one of the clubs or organizations.
- Visit the Title I Family Resource Room for free workbooks, kits, and information on how to help your child with homework.
- Keep up with your child's progress, assignments, and lunch account on Infinite Campus Parent Portal.
- Come to as many Title I parent nights and workshops that you can.

  - Transportation changes can only be made with a written note, fax or email. No phone calls. A phone call will be made to verify notes.

### Things To Expect from RMS...



- 1. Info on schedule pickup will be sent out toward the end of the summer.
- 2. Tiger Tales newsletter & calendar—sent home with students at the beginning of each month.
- 3. Progress Reports—halfway through 9 weeks, to be signed and returned to school.
- Report Cards—every 9 weeks, to be signed and returned to school.
- Title I Surveys—every fall and spring. We welcome your input for school improvement ideas.
- Picture order forms every fall and spring.
- 7. Various handouts about events and opportunities.

Text Alerts are sent out on the day that something is sent home. Please remind students to give you this important information!
