Title I Spring Survey by the Numbers

- GES parents took part in the 2023 TItle I Spring Survey from February 23rd March 10th.
- The survey was available online as a Google Forms document or as a printed hard copy.
- Students who had a returned survey on file by Friday, March 10th received a special treat.
- 288 surveys were submitted. 272 students had surveys completed which is 46% of our student population!
- 6 paper copies were requested and distributed with 4 returned by the deadline.
- 7 surveys were translated into 2 languages, Simplified Chinese and Spanish, with 4 returned.
- Second grade had the highest participation percentage with 59% of their grade-level completing a survey.
- Mrs. Moody's class had the best participation with 75%!




I think community-based and work-based field trips provide great learning experiences and help students make connections to real life outside of the classroom.
